- To help us navigate a way forward we will have Jon Payne from the Evangelical Free Church in America, who met with our Consistory and future of the church team, come for a visit on next Sunday September 26. Pastor Jon will deliver the message; and then following the worship service we will have a Q&A time in the sanctuary. - At the September 13 Consistory meeting the following schedule was agreed upon:
  - Sunday October 10 following worship we will have a special congregational meeting to vote on whether to leave the RCA; and then a second vote on what denomination to affiliate with. The RCA book of church order requires a church to transfer to another existing denomination—going independent is not an option. Thus far, the elder and Consistory discernment has been that the EFCA would be the best and healthiest affiliation for our congregation.
  - Sunday, November 14 following worship will be our regular annual congregational meeting to do the Consistory election and approve the 2022 budget.
